

<p>Course Description:</p> <p>This course provides extensive opportunities for students to speak and interact in French independently. Students will develop their listening, speaking, reading, and writing skills, apply language learning strategies in a wide variety of real-life situations, and develop their creative and critical thinking skills through responding to and interacting with a variety of oral and written texts. Course Evaluation: Student Evaluation consists of three components...

1) Learning Skills & Work Habits:
 Students are evaluated on 6 Learning Skills & Work Habits. They are:

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Responsibility • Organization • Independent Work 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Collaboration • Initiative • Self-Regulation 	<p>These six attributes are evaluated on a scale of Excellent (E), Good (G), Satisfactory (S) & Needs Improvement (N) and reported on the report card. They are not included in the course mark, unless specified in the curriculum expectations.</p>
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2) Term Mark (Assessment of Learning):
 Student performance standards for knowledge and skills are described in the curriculum Achievement Chart. The curriculum is assessed in four strands:

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Listening 25% • Speaking 25% • Reading 25% • Writing 25% 	<p>Evaluation of these four strands generates the term mark. The term mark accounts for 70% of the final mark.</p> <p>It is the student's responsibility to submit evidence of learning.</p>
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3) Final Evaluation (Assessment of Learning):
 The final evaluation, administered at or towards the end of the course is based on the evidence shown to the right. The final evaluation accounts for 30% of the final mark.

<p>The final evaluation consists of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Oral Interview Exam (reading, listening & writing) 30%
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Final Mark = 70% Term Mark + 30% Final Evaluation
